WHAT ARE WE ABOUT?

Howell Police Cadets are a youth-adult program sponsored by the Howell Township Police Department. The membership of the Post is made for young men and women ages 14 (and graduated 8th grade) through 21 years old.

Membership is strictly volunteer and non-profit.

Cadets are not police officers and have no police authority.

All equipment, uniforms, academies, trainings, and conferences are provided free of charge by the Howell Police Department. Cadets are only responsible for the purchase of boots, civilian attire, name plate, and \$10 monthly dues.



DUTIES & TRAINING

The Howell Township Police Cadets supplement the Howell Township Police Department by providing assistance to sworn officers on patrol and at special events with:

- Traffic & Crowd Control
- Crime Prevention & Public Relations
- Assisting with Municipal Court

Cadets benefit from an early education in Law Enforcement with:

- Training & Guest Speakers
- Ride-Alongs with officers during their shifts
- Attending local and regional trainings and seminars
- Ability to apply for internships



MEETING SCHEDULE

MEETINGS

Police Cadets will meet on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays of the month (starting at 7:00 pm) with exception of July, August, November and December. Meetings will be held on the 2nd Thursdays of those months.

LOCATION

Howell Township Police Department (300 Old Tavern Road – Howell) or the Howell PAL (115 Kent Road – Howell).

PHYSICAL TRAINING ATTIRE

Plain black shorts and running sneakers with a plain blue navy t-shirt. Sweat pants and sweatshirt for winter uniform.

EVENT & DRILL TRAINING

Attire for meetings & functions are issued uniforms or black dress pants with black shoes or boots and a dark blue dress shirt with a tie (provided).

Training takes place at both meetings and other scheduled dates.
